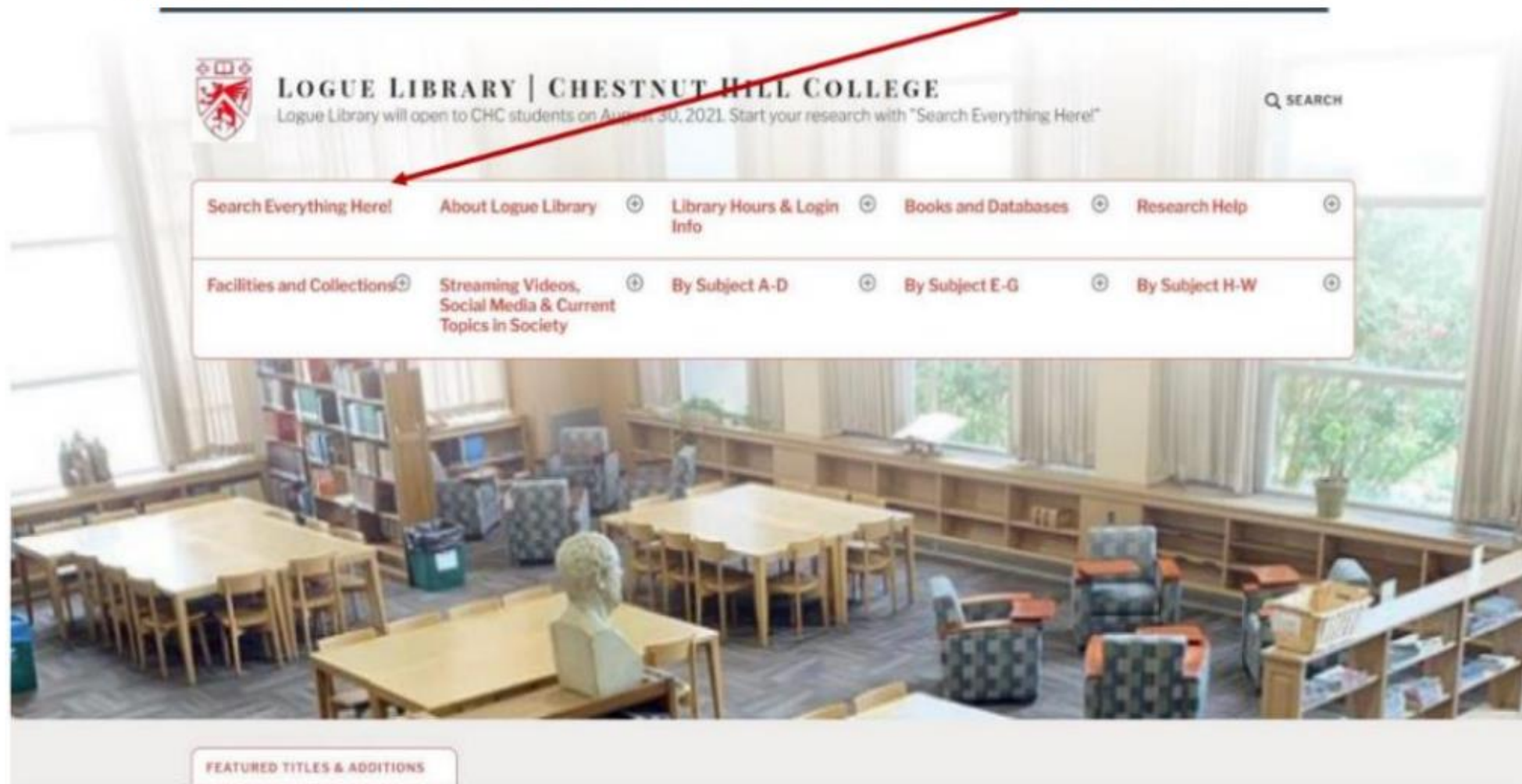

**Step 1: Go to Logue's website and click on the tab, "Search Everything Here!"**


